Tracy has studied with some of Australia's finest practitioners and teachers including **Donald Smith**, **James Christiansen** and **Merlyn Quaife**. In 1997 Tracy travelled to London to study contemporary vocal technique with **Jane Manning**.

In 2002 she was given the opportunity to study contemporary classical vocal technique with several teacher/performers of international distinction: **Phyllis Bryn-Julson** of Peabody Conservatorium, Baltimore, **Linda Wise**, Paris, France and **Jane Manning**, London, United Kingdom. This program was granted funding from the **Australia Council for the Arts Music Fund**, the **Ian Potter Cultural Foundation**, and the **University of Ballarat**.

Voice Teaching & Research

Tracy has over 20 years experience teaching classical and contemporary styles to actors and music theatre singers. She has taught at the Arts Academy, University of Ballarat for over 12 years, and is completing a PhD on the science of music theatre singing techniques. She traveled to the USA in 2008 to train in Somatic VoiceworkTM, *The LoVetri Method*, and has given papers and workshops on the influence of vocal registers in male and female music singers in France, and most states of Australia. Previous students have gone on to work in shows including *Jersey Boys*, *Hairspray*, *West Side Story*, *Wicked*, *Spamelot*, and *The Ten Tenors*, others have come onto develop careers as cabaret artists and writers, singers on cruise ships, or as actor singers for Universal Studios in Japan and Singapore.
